ESL Course

The CrossTalk Training Course 2022 is a 21-week ESL course that is divided into two terms with a two-week holiday break between terms. The CrossTalk ESL Course focuses on reading, writing, listening and speaking with special emphasis given to pronunciation, comprehension and grammar. Students are introduced to the Australian culture and visit places of historical plus cultural interest. The CrossTalk course is delivered in a Christian setting where students enjoy Bible English each morning, visit local churches and attend Christian conferences.

- Course Goals:**
- **ESL** - *equip* you to read, write, listen and speak English well.
 - **SPIRITUAL** - *encourage* you to grow closer to Jesus Christ.
 - **RELATIONAL** - *enlarge* your relationships with Australians.
 - **CULTURAL** - *enhance* your understanding of Australian culture.
 - **MISSIONAL** - *engage* you with local churches and world missions.

- ESL Course:**
- The CrossTalk ESL course in 2022 will deliver ESL (English as a Second Language) training from Post Beginner to Intermediate level.
- **Level 1** (1st Term) 12 weeks (including one week of orientation)
 - **Level 2** (2nd Term) 9 weeks
- # In addition to delivering the above ESL programs the College can also help with IELTS Preparation.

Course Dates: The Course is divided into two terms:

Term 1: Tuesday 5th July to Friday 23rd September 2022
12 weeks (including one week of orientation)

- Note: Overseas students are to arrive on Monday 4th July 2022

Term 2: Monday 10th October to Friday 9th December 2022 (9 weeks)

 - CrossCountry: Monday 31st October to Wednesday 2nd November.

Daily Program: 8:30am-1:00pm teacher directed class time
2:00pm-3:30pm student directed study time

- Course Options:** There are two study options:
- **Full Course:** for students who can confirm enrolment for the entire course.
 - **Partial Course:** for students who can only enrol in part of the course.
 - **Note:** Students must choose one of the above options prior to enrolment.
